

ENHANCING ASCHAM - Hillingdon Project

We are embarking on our *Hillingdon Project*, with building due to begin in the coming September holidays. Our good fortune is to have 80% of the funds required already, thanks to the Federal Government's *Building the Education Revolution* initiative. Our architects, Tzannes Associates, have briefed parents and staff on their plans which comprise two pavilions connected to the original Hillingdon, one housing a library and hall, the other with two classrooms. When the project is completed next year, Hillingdon will not only enjoy splendid new facilities, it will also be unified by the Year 2 classrooms coming back into the Hillingdon precinct. This in turn will free the Multi Purpose Building for use by the Senior School and Fiona, allowing relocation of subject areas to enhance learning facilities for their students as well.

While the basic spaces are secure with the government funding, the details which will make the new buildings a benchmark of excellence require another \$800,000 of funding.

If you have not had the opportunity to view the plans, the diagram below shows where the two pavilions will stand in relation to the existing Hillingdon building, and an impression of the larger addition housing the library and hall, as it would be seen from the bottom of the playground area looking back towards Hillingdon.
