Responsibilities

- Participate in all AHA sessions, including those run by external facilitators, from 8am 4pm daily.
 Activities include but are not limited to, physical activity, creative or artistic tasks and academic
 extension tasks. The AHA Casual may be asked to plan up to 2 of these sessions and will be
 supported in their development and delivery.
- Supervise students on off-site excursions
- Supervise children both indoors and outdoors during recess and lunch breaks.
- Facilitate morning and afternoon carline duty.
- Work effectively as a member of a team to share in program preparation and delivery
- Attend planning and training sessions as required.
- Ensure the basic cleanliness, safety and security of all AHA spaces
- Support the AHA manager in the delivery of all aspects of the Ascham Holiday Academy.

- Report any incidents to the daily supervisor who will inform the parents if required. In the event of a critical incident administer first aid and call 000 (if required) before contacting the AHA manager.
