Ascham School provides a broad range of academic, extra and co-curricular opportunities. Tuition Fees are inclusive of online licenses required for most subjects, ICT costs and participation in other compulsory activities such as Open Days and House activities. School excursions, camps and co-curricular activities are additional and are charged separately. Parents will be advised of any additional charges as part of accepting the additional goods or services being provided.

ADDITIONAL COSTS

DESCRIPTION	YEAR GROUP	COST
Excursions and Camps	Prep to Year 12	Excursions and Camps are part of the NSW school curriculum and are therefore compulsory. Fees are charged to meet the costs charged by providers. Parents will be separately advised of the final costs.
Music & Co-curricular Activities, Functions and Events	Prep to Year 12	As these are unique for each student, parents will be directly advised of the additional charges for each activity, function or event.

SIBLING DISCOUNT

Sibling discounts will apply to Tuition and Boarding fees of subsequent daughter(s) concurrently attending the School. The eldest daughter is charged full fees, with a discount for younger siblings

The discount applicable is applied once per year to the first account statement of the year.

APPLICATION AND ENTRANCE FEES

All application and entrance fees are non-refundable and are not credited towards tuition fees.

Application Fee	\$300 per student (non-refundable) is required upon lodgment of an application for enrolment
Entrance Fee	\$6,000 per student (non-refundable) is required to secure the position once an offer has been made.

OVERSEAS PUPIL LEVY

This fee will be charged in two instalments of \$3,000 per semester.

FEES	AMOUNT
Levy Fee	A levy of \$6,000 per annum will apply to all Full Fee Paying Overseas Students (FFPOS) for whom the School receives no Commonwealth or State funding.

FEE DUE DATES

Fee Statements are issued prior to the commencement of each School term, with a final statement in December. The first four fee statements will represent one quarter of the annual tuition and boarding fee plus any sundry costs for elective or co-curricular activities of the prior term. The final supplementary statement issued in December will cover any sundry expenses and Co-curricular activities in term 4.

OVERDUE ACCOUNTS

A payment reminder notice will be issued following the fee payment due date and continued non-payment will incur a late payment administration charge of \$200. If school fees are unpaid and overdue, students will not be allowed to attend or participate in co-curricular activities, tours or similar. If fees continue to be unpaid, the student will not be able to attend the School until all fees are fully paid or a formal arrangement for the payment of fees has been agreed to by the Head of Finance. Thereafter, external debt collectors may be used, the costs of which will be billed to your account.

FEES IN ADVANCE

The School Fees in Advance Program offers parents the ability to pay a minimum of three years in advance based on the current fee schedule (subject to various conditions). Please follow the link below for more information or contact the Finance Office with any queries.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

At least one term's notice of withdrawal is required to be provided in writing to the Head of School if a student is to be withdrawn from the School or is changing from a boarder to a day girl. In the event that a student is withdrawn without the required notice period, one term's fee (plus GST) in lieu of notice will be charged. If a boarding student in Year 12 is withdrawn part way through the year, the School will charge the full year's boarding fee.

VOLUNTARY DONATIONS

Families will have the opportunity on each tuition fee statement to make a voluntary tax-deductible contribution of \$300 to the Ascham Foundation Scholarship Fund. This fund supports the School's scholarship program. A tax receipt for all donations will be issued in July following the end of each financial year. All donations are greatly appreciated and support the school's diversity and inclusion objectives.
